Many bags offer sub zero temperature ratings and this goes to show that the bag is the warmest bag that is available in the market. Some sleeping bags are designed to be light and are meant for use in warm environments as well as in cars and trucks. Last of all is the price of the bag. Though this is never the most important deciding point for buying your sleeping bag, it is no doubt important. Price is not a very good indicator of the quality of any product or service, the same applies to sleeping bags. Many bags have similar features but the prices range from good to highly irrational. Lend your attention to sleeping bags that have a lot of craftsmanship and good quality material. You will be glad you did.
