First of all, one of the most common causes of aggressive kittens is the lack of early handling by people. This is often seen in kittens who are rescued from the wild.

However this lack of early handling of kittens can be overcome if you have time and patience. Slowly build up how much time your cat tolerates being handled over time.

Another common cause of aggressive kitten problems is being raised exclusively by humans. Kittens who are raised without other kittens often do not know the difference between play biting and actual biting. So instead of guarding their teeth when they play they'll actually bite with full force.

The easiest way to solve this problem is to simply stop playing with your kitten if they do give you a painful bite. Once they realize they giving a full force results in a stoppage of play their behavior will often change.

The biting of toes is a third common aggressive kitten problem that people often experience. This one is often the easiest one to solve because it is often caused by boredom.

The easiest way to solve this problem is by giving your kittens more toys, or by playing with them more frequently.

Remember the most important thing is to behave consistently towards your kitten so they understand clearly what type of behavior is expected from them.
