Young puppies have got small stomachs so they need a lot of small meals on a daily basis. Start by providing the lowest amount of recommended quantity and increase this only if your puppy begins to look thin - bear in mind that an obese puppy turns into an over weight adult dog.

ADULT DOGS

An adult dog will have to be changed from a growth diet to adult food fairly gradually. Introduce them slowly to their new food, at first mixing it with their existing food and reducing it until they are happy to accept their new diet.

Doing it this way should prevent them from having any stomach upsets.

A adult dog ought to look sleek and still have a noticeable waistline. You really should be able to just feel their ribs when stroked.

TREATS

Just about all dogs enjoy having treats but some are extremely high in calories. Low-calorie treats are available so if your dog easily gains weight these are certainly the best choice.

Treats can also be great to use as a part of a training routine and also are frequently used to be able to tempt your dog to obey when teaching obedience.
